With two teenage boys on the loose around the house, the family bathroom needed to be robust, but also chic. “They wanted a sophisticated yet timeless feel that was not bland or boring and could incorporate some colour,” says Frances, referring to the blue Nood Co ‘Pill’ basin. The silestone benchtop is non-porous and stain-resistant, and the floor and walls are completely tiled, meaning the entire space is easy to wipe clean. Teenager-proof, indeed.
